



## Make a butterfly kite





a large sheet 2 wooden of paper sticks



paints or

crayons

scissors and

sticky tape



a hole

punch



string and ribbon



- Fold the piece of paper in half and draw half of a butterfly, with the body along the fold. Cut out the butterfly shape with the scissors.
- 5 Tape one stick along the middle of the butterfly and the other stick across the wings. Tape the ribbon to the bottom of the butterfly.

2 Decorate the butterfly with paints or crayons. Mark a hole near the top of the butterfly's body and cover the mark with sticky

4 Put the string through the hole, and make a knot.
