



Andrew Does he never forget to do his homework?

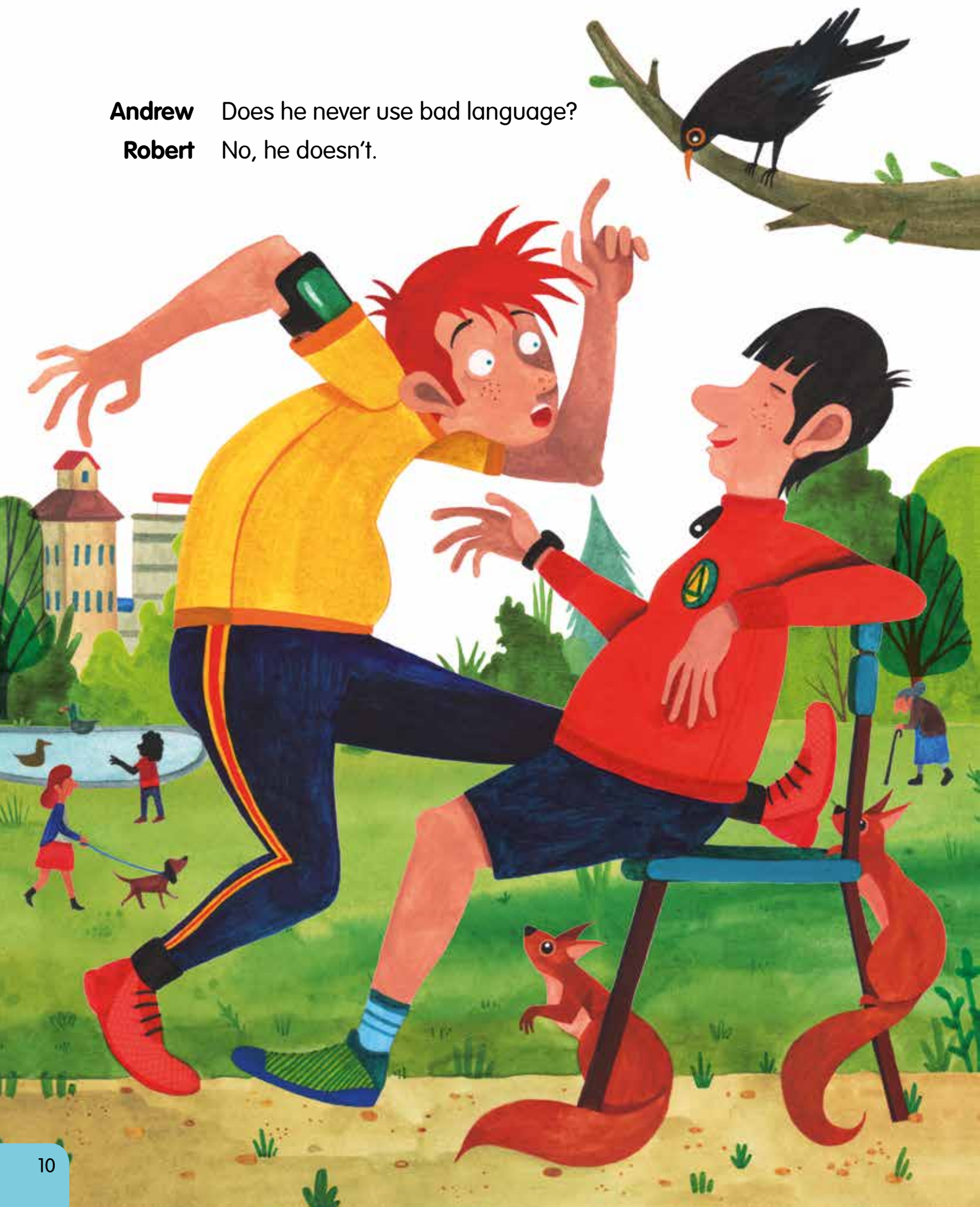
Robert No, he doesn't. Never!
