



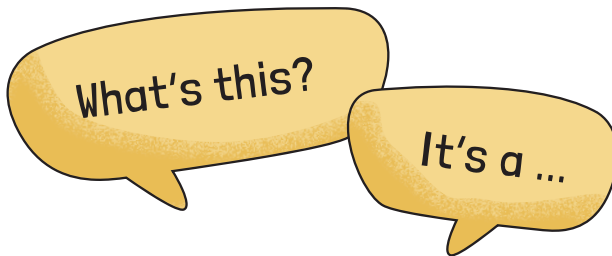

Make a compass

You need:



a magnet that has the north pole marked



a needle



a piece of thick paper



water



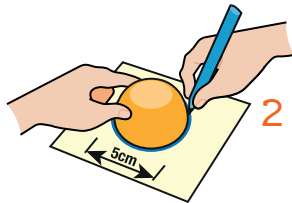
a large bowl



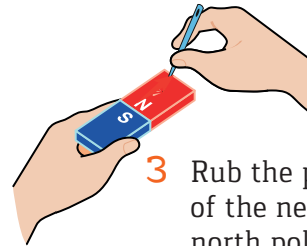
a pencil and scissors



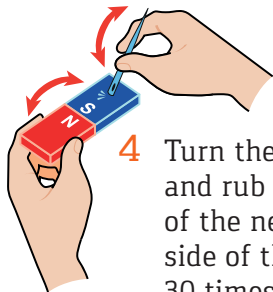
- 1 Fill the bowl with water.



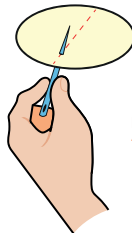
- 2 With the pencil, draw a circle of about 5 cm in diameter on the paper and cut it out with the scissors.



- 3 Rub the pointed end of the needle on the north pole side of the magnet 30 times in the same direction.



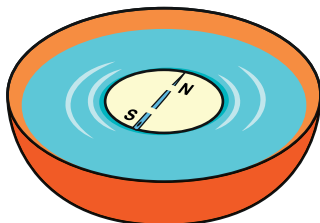
- 4 Turn the magnet over and rub the other end of the needle on this side of the magnet 30 times in the same direction.



- 5 Push the needle through the circle of paper so it is fixed.



- 6 Write N for north on the paper with the pointed end of the needle and S for south at the other end.



- 7 Put the paper circle with the needle on top of the water in the bowl so that it floats and rotates. When it stops, the pointed end of the needle will point to the north and the other end to the south. Where are the things in the room? In your house or school? In your town or city?
