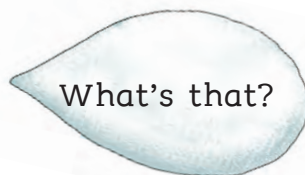

Model Sun, Earth and Moon

Make your own rotating Sun, Earth and Moon.

You need:

a paper plate

a piece of white card

colours or paints

a hole puncher

three brass fasteners

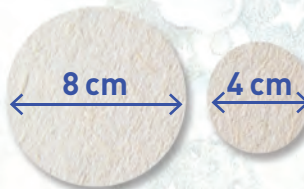
scissors

- 1 Draw and cut out the Earth and Moon. Then cut two long rectangles of card.

- 2 Colour the paper plate yellow (for the Sun), colour the Earth green and blue and the Moon white or grey.

- 3 Make a hole using the hole puncher at the end of each long piece of card and in the middle of the Sun, Earth and Moon.

- 4 Fasten the pieces together using brass fasteners.
