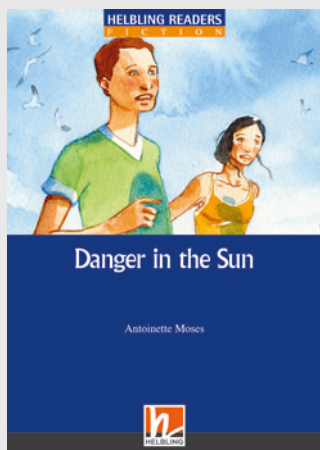
**OSCAR WILDE****The Picture of Dorian Gray**

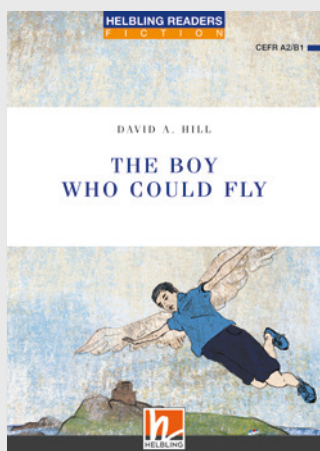

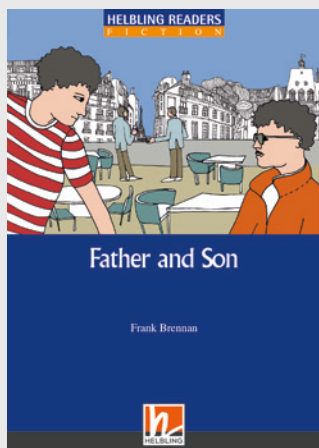

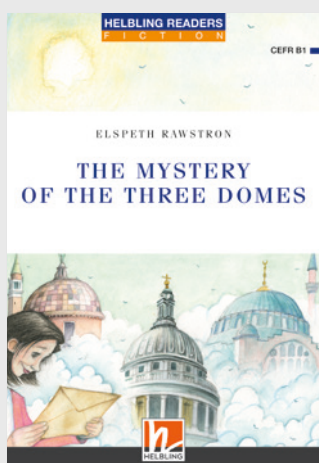
